#### Heading West on the 210 Freeway



### HOW CAN I PREPARE FOR MY SURGERY OR PROCEDURE?

- Follow all directions and preparation instructions given to you by your doctor. Should you have any problems or questions about these preparations, please call your doctor.
- Arrange for a family member or friend to be available to take you home after your surgery or procedure. We require this for your safety. Please notify your doctor if this is a problem; if so, your procedure may need to be rescheduled.
- If you are taking any medications, please check with your doctor for instructions.

#### WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

- √ A list of all your allergies
- ✓ A list of medications that you are currently taking
- ✓ Any medical forms given to you by your doctor
- √ Your insurance identification card
- √ Driver's License / Photo ID Card

#### **CONTACT INFORMATION?**

Your doctor's office provides us with the contact information that you provided them. If that information has changed, please provide us with the current contact information so that we may reach you the night before your surgery or procedure.

## WHAT CAN I EXPECT AFTER MY PROCEDURE?

You are usually able to go home within two hours following your procedure.
State law requires that after any surgery or procedure involving anesthesia or sedation, you must be discharged to a responsible person who can drive you home. A nurse will call you the next day to check on your progress. If any problem develops after you return home, please contact your physician immediately.

### WHAT ABOUT INSURANCE BILLING?

Depending on your method of payment or the type of coverage provided by your health plan, SSCA may require payment for the co-pay/deductible upon admission. Contact SSCA's billing department (626) 471-9901 in advance if you have questions.
